Only blue and red belts in all divisions make sure your athlete has their own belt.

Coaches:

Dress: Track Suite coaches must have taken Official US Karate coaching license.

3. KATA:

All normal Kata divisions. One athlete can only compete in one division.

4. KUMITE:

WKF US karate Rules will be strictly enforced. Rules can be view at www.karatedoalliance.com
All Junior matches will stop at half time and competitors can go to their coaches for Instructions.

REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT: Mouth guard, WKF-approved hand mitts and footpads, groin cup (males) and shin-instep guards are for all ages.
